**REGULAR MEETING**

The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Loomis held a Regular Meeting on April 13, 2026 at the Loomis Community Building. Notice of the meeting was published in the Holdrege Daily Citizen and posted at the Loomis Post Office, Loomis Village Office, First State Bank of Loomis and on the Village website. The agenda for said meeting was kept continuously at the office of the Village Clerk.

Chairman Keith Fagot opened the meeting at 7:00PM.

Chairman Fagot explained that the meeting would be conducted under the Open Meeting Laws of the State of Nebraska and that a copy of those laws was placed on the counter of the meeting room for anyone who wished to read them.

Max moved and Melanie seconded to approve the agenda. Voting Aye: Don, Keith, Max, Melanie, Ben. Voting Nay: None. The motion passed 5/0.

Melanie moved and Max seconded to approve the previous month's regular meeting minutes. Voting Aye: Don, Keith, Melanie, Max, Ben. Voting Nay: None. Motion passed 5/0.

Keith moved and Ben seconded that the financial reports be approved as presented: Voting Aye: Don, Keith, Melanie, Max, Ben. Voting Nay: None. Motion passed 5/0.

Motion by Don and second by Keith to grant permission for Colby Gray to sell fireworks in the city limits following all village ordinances and state law concerning the sale of fireworks and times for sale. Voting YES: Don, Melanie, Ben, Keith, Max. The motion carried 5/0.

The Loomis Village Clean Up day was discussed and finalized for April 20, 2026. Notice has been posted on the website and in the post office.

The board discussed the Gas Choice Program. Motion by Keith and second by Melanie that the board will utilize ACE as our gas provider and Lori Vinzant will submit the paperwork and complete the process for the Village. Voting YES: Max, Ben, Keith, Melanie, Don. Voting NO: None. The motion carried 5/0.

Three lawn care quotations were presented for the summer fertilizer and weed control of the Loomis Baseball/Softball Complex. Motion by Keith and second by Max to accept the lowest quote by Green Landscapes for the 2026 lawn season. Voting YES: Don, Melanie, Ben, Keith, Max. Voting Nay: None. The motion carried 5/0.

Chairman Fagot presented a nuisance report and told the board that a couple of letters are being sent concerning the licensing of vehicles.

A building permit was submitted in the name of Don Masten for the placement of a storage container on his property. Motion by Keith and second by Ben to accept the permit. Voting YES: Max, Melanie, Ben, Keith. Voting NO: None. Abstaining: Don. The motion carried 4/0 with 1 abstention.

The Village Clerk reported on the following items: Rehab of the drainage ditch in the park with the installation of a bridge, painting of the bleachers at the ball fields, the removal of two trees from the Village terraces and the installation of new lights in the Village Shop, as well as the current armor coating of the streets.

The next meeting will be held at 7:00PM at the Loomis Community Building on Monday, May 11, 2026.

Motion by Max and second by Melanie to adjourn the meeting. Voting Aye: Don, Keith, Ben, Melanie, Max. Voting Nay: None. Motion passed 5/0.
