Dear New Homeowners,

Welcome to the Village of Loomis. Enclosed is some information about some common rules and regulations of the Village. If you have questions about other ordinances, please stop in and visit someone at the Village office.

Utility bills are billed out around the fifth (1st) of each month. All charges are for previous month's usage. This charge is a flat monthly fee that currently includes garbage (\$16.21), Sewer (\$10.50), Water (\$17.94), & Sales Tax for a total of forty-five and 33/100 (\$45.33) dollars. Payments can be paid by mail (at the address listed above), delivered to the Village Office located at 301 Commercial St, Mon-Fri, 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. **OR** at the First State Bank of Loomis located at 211 Commercial St., Mon-Fri, 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m., Sat 8:00 a.m.-11:00 a.m. You may also put your payment in the night deposit box at the bank. We only accept cash or check at this time for payment. You may also have the option to have your bank automatically mail us a payment on your behalf. You will need to go into your online banking or talk with your bank if that is something you want to explore. If payments are not received by the 25th of the month, there may be a late fee charged to your account of 18%. Any notice of disconnect should have payments delivered to the Village office to ensure no additional disconnect fees are applied. If you would like to have your bill emailed rather than sent by mail, please stop in and provide that information at the Village Office.

Garbage pickup is on Wednesday of every week. **Grass, wood, yard debris, or batteries are not allowed in the dumpsters, rollouts, or piled on the ground.** Grass, wood, and yard debris can be dumped at our yard waste site located ¼ mile East of Loomis, North of the railroad tracks on the West side. A one time access key fee and a small annual renewal of the key allows usage of our yard waste site as a resident of Loomis as long as there is no illegal dumping. Penalty fees may be charged to residents who leave or dump items not allowed at the site. Once you have your key card, you will have access to the site at all times. Security cameras are in place to ensure everyone is following the rules. If you have questions regarding what can and should be dumped at our site, please come into the office and visit.

There is a recycling rollout located behind The Bridal Isle (315 Commercial St.) in the alley for your convenience. A recycling pamphlet will accompany this letter to inform you of what items can and cannot be recycled at our location. This is also provided to residents at no charge.

Loomis does have a dog tag ordinance in place. All dogs that are six (6) months or older must be licensed at the Village Office. Dog tags are due the first of the year. Dogs must be leashed at all times if off your property. Dogs running at large will be picked up and impounded. Loomis does have an animal ordinance that does not allow any person to have more than 3 dog &/or cats or any combination of the two per household. You may register your dogs at the village office.

Fire pits are allowed in town as long as there is a screened cover over top to prevent embers from drifting and starting unwanted fires. Flames must also be kept below 2ft in height and only untreated wood or commercially manufactured starter logs shall be burnt. Anyone under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult when utilizing a fire pit.

ATV/UTV's and Golf Carts are also allowed to be driven in town as long as you have first received a permit at the Village Office. Drivers must be at least 18 years of age. No ATV/UTV's or golf carts are allowed to be driven after dark. There is an annual permit fee associated with this privilege. Please stop by the Office to get more details of what is required to comply with this ordinance.
